This firm's current fee structure has been in place since 2005. Although we are certainly mindful of the necessity to keep increases in the District's expenses, including the cost of legal services, to a minimum, it has become necessary for us to adjust our hourly rates effective May 1, 2023, as follows:

Attorneys/Partners:	\$275.00 per hour
Attorneys/Associates:	\$225.00 per hour

This hourly fee structure will be adjusted on a periodic basis in connection with the District's budget process no later than every third Fiscal Year to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index published by the U.S. Department of Labor. The CPI has reflected a 54% increase since the year 2005 and we have not raised our fees during that time.
