A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Jason Pierman called the April 1, 2025, Regular Board Meeting of the Monterey/Congress Community Development District ("District") to order at 6:07 p.m. at 100 Lake Monterey Circle, Boynton Beach, Florida 33426.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Mr. Pierman presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in *The Palm Beach Post* on September 25, 2024, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Regular Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

Mr. Pierman determined that the attendance of Chairperson Libia Cristancho, Vice Chairman Willie Ford and Supervisors Diana Puentes and Lissette Montavo constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.
